

Medina County Health Department Expands Hours at Wadsworth Clinic

Wadsworth, Ohio—The Medina County Health Department is adding morning hours to the child and adolescent immunization clinic located at Summa Wadsworth Rittman Hospital Founder's Hall. The clinic is available on the fourth Wednesday of the month from 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. Appointments for immunizations are recommended. The new clinic hours at Founder's Hall will replace the immunization clinic at the Knights of Columbus Hall at 148 N. Lyman Street in Wadsworth on the first Wednesday of the month.

“Having full day clinic hours in Wadsworth will provide parents with more options for scheduling their child or teen for an immunization appointment,” said Lisa Strebler, RN, MSN, Public Health Nursing Director.

For an appointment, please call 330-723-9688 or toll-free at 1-888-723-9688. A select number of adult vaccines are also available by appointment at this clinic. The clinic accepts Medicaid, Care Source, Well Care, and Buckeye Community insurance. The non-Medicaid vaccine administration fee is \$10 per vaccine for Medina County children and adolescents and \$14.50 per vaccine for out-of-county children and adolescents. No child will be denied immunizations due to inability to pay. Services are partially supported by your local property tax health levy.

The Medina County Health Department also provides child and adolescent immunizations at the following locations:

- Lodi Resource Center, 119 Bank Street, monthly on the 3rd Wednesday, 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.
